- Iceland has about 360,000 inhabitants
- Reykjavik city, 122.852 inhabitants
- Preschool age 18 months to 6 years, 98% attend preschool
- Primary schools 6-16 years
- Secondary education 17-19 years
- University education ca 25.000 students
- Reykjavik pre- and primary schools 21.000 students
- We didn't close our pre- and primary schools during the pandemic
- Secondary education was online and so was University education
